

Altar Society Meeting – January 11, 2010

Our prices have once again been adjusted to reflect an increase from last year. The children's price has been raised to \$4.00 per child (age 4-10), and the family maximum this year will be \$25.00.

We decided to sell our leftover soup for \$6.00 per quart of chicken noodle and \$4.00 per quart of chile. Joan will price the leftover pies according to size and type of pie.

The quilt raffle drawing will be held on Sunday Jan. 31, 2010.

The Altar Society will have a table set up at the Ministry Fair. The pictures for the poster will be updated after the noodle making day.

Father Mike has been approached by a single father from our parish who is jobless and would like financial support for a class he'd like to take in order to improve his job skills. The cost of the class is \$245.00. It was decided that the Altar Society would donate \$145.00 to him.

We went to the church to watch a short DVD of the mission trip to St. Lucia.
