

Resurrection Altar Society Meeting – April 11, 2011

The meeting was called to order by President Julie Brezenski with 7 members present.

The “Rediscovering Catholicism” booklets have been ordered and will be distributed during Holy Week Services. We purchased 250 books at \$3 each. They come with an insert which can be used to order more booklets for free. We will reevaluate any future need at a later date.

Enclosed is the grocery list used to purchase the supplies for the banana splits for the Going Bananas event. It was suggested that we eliminate serving whipped cream & maraschino cherries in the future. Other than the ice cream becoming soft before being served, the kids enjoyed it.

Gerri Zaruba, as a representative from the Liturgy Committee, suggested that we form an “Honor Guard” which could attend smaller funerals held at Resurrection. No definitive action was taken.

Next year’s activities were discussed, including:

- Serving egg casseroles and coffee cakes for Catechetical Sunday (Anita Leschinsky and Louise Vodehnal offered to chair this event)

- Serving a baked potato bar on Ash Wednesday, including macaroni and cheese for the children
