In order to catch the attention of the attendees, it was discussed whether or not to have a member at the door with the donation basket.

Geri Zaruba has several games purchased for the children to play that evening. The craft rooms are staffed and some of the crafts were prepped during the meeting.

The Giving Tree will be set up Nov. 18th. If anyone knows of a family or individual in need, please let Marcia Reidy or Sharon Britten know. A deadline of December 18 will be given. The gifts will be delivered at 1:00 pm that day. No gifts will be accepted or delivered after that time.

New Business:

The Ministry Fair poster board needs updated before the soup supper. It was suggested to have the table staffed in order to personally invite any women of the parish to join.

The structure of the mini-parishes was discussed with Father Mike. It was determined that they no longer serve a purpose and should be dissolved. As new members join the parish, their names will be randomly divided among the calling groups.

Ruby Harders has agreed to chair the Calling Tree. It will continue to be used to solicit donations for the soup supper and funerals.

Joan Wiese and Barb Wiczorek have agreed to be co-chairs of the Funeral Committee.
