Resurrection Altar Society Meeting – December 13, 2010

The meeting was called to order by President Julie Brezenski with eight members present.

Anita Pinon, representing NAF Multicultural Human Development Corporation, was present to give us an overview of what their organization does and some of the needs that are present. The Altar Society donated \$107.00 last month in order to provide a Thanksgiving Day meal for four families that are enrolled in their program.

The minutes from the November meeting were read by Sharon Hernandez. Corrections to the minutes were made as such: the boxes of hot dogs purchased for Advent Evening had 40 hot dogs each and the financial report ending balance should have read \$2190.05. A motion to accept the corrected minutes was made by Joan Wiese and seconded by Kim Adair.

The Financial Report was read by Kim Adair. Our income for the month was \$418.00 and our expenses were \$477.24, leaving a balance of \$2130.81.

Advent Evening was well attended. The soup and hot dogs were all consumed, so had nothing left over to sell. It was suggested that we purchase an additional 20-30 hot dogs for next year. We discussed having the K of C manage the children's games in the future rather than provide goodie bags. Some of the attendees missed the bingo game, so may need to bring that back next year. Father Mike suggested that we substitute a prayer service of some type rather than Mass, as it isn't usually well attended and most people have difficulty getting there from work in time.

The bake sale profited \$592.75 with only a couple of items left over. Those were donated to Mike Follmer to use at the ARC dinners.

The Altar Society web site was recently updated, so if it's been awhile since you've viewed it, it will have a new layout.

The Giving Tree gifts need to be returned to the church by December 18th at 1:00 pm for delivery at that time.

Christmas fruit baskets will be assembled Sunday December 19th for delivery soon thereafter. It was voted to assemble an additional four baskets to donate to the four families enrolled in the NAF program.
