DIOCESAN APPEAL: This month the annual Diocesan Appeal, *Living Our Faith, Sharing our Gifts...Together* begins. Appeal 2010 will fund ministries throughout central and western Nebraska. The annual Appeal funds 32% of the diocesan budget. This is a wonderful opportunity to assess our stewardship of time, talent, and treasure. All families are asked to discern their gifts and participate according to what they have received.

In order for our parish to reach its goal of \$29,232.00, all families are asked to consider a gift of at least 10% over their annual parish contribution. This may be a one-time gift or a pledge, payable over 8 months. Your contribution to the Appeal may also be made online at www.gidiocese.org. Any money that is raised over our goal may stay in our parish.

Appeal Sunday is the weekend of February 21st. You will receive information in the mail detailing the Appeal during the week of February 14th. The mailing will include letters from Bishop Dendinger, a brochure and a pledge envelope to be used on Appeal Weekend.

We're asked to sit down and evaluate all our circumstances—our time, talent, and treasure, and how we can contribute. Christ calls us to make a difference where we can. Ask yourself...is this an area where I can make a difference?

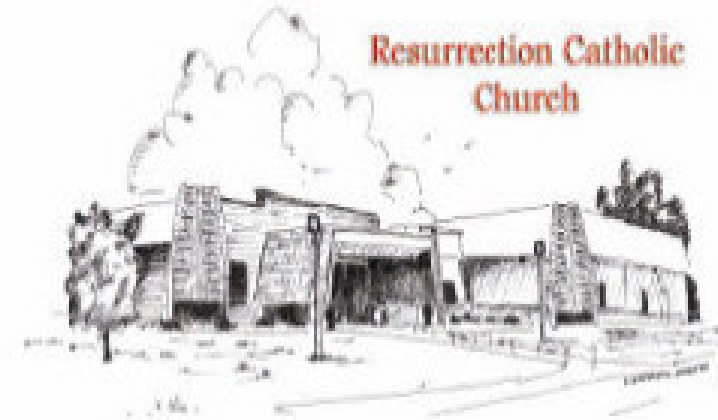
