

## Resurrection Altar Society Meeting – October 2010

The meeting was called to order by President Julie Brezenski with nine members present.

The minutes from the September meeting were read by Sharon Hernandez. ### **Old Business:**

The funeral committee served 350 people for Mark Noziska's funeral dinner. A card was passed around and signed in appreciation to Jeanette Weakland for all of her efforts in coordinating the funeral dinners.

The Trunk or Treat function has been cancelled due to lack of time for preparation.

### **New Business:**

The calling committee is in need of a new chairperson, as Jean Vaughn is stepping down after many years of service. A notice will be placed in the bulletin asking for a volunteer to serve in this capacity.

The Gathering Table Dinner for the Salvation Army will be served November 21, 2010. Gina Woods will be calling for volunteers to assist in preparing the meal. She needs approximately ten people. The K of C will help serve and clean up.

Priesthood Sunday will be celebrated October 31, 2010. The Altar Society will purchase a gift certificate for Father Mike in appreciation for his service to our parish community. The CLC classes will be asked to write personal notes to Fr. Mike as well.

It was decided to proceed with planning a social event to the Scarecrow Patch north of St. Libory. The event will be held October 24, 2010 from 4-7:00 pm. Gina will post notices around the church and also send notes home with the CLC students. All parish members are encouraged to attend.

The Giving Tree will be put up the weekend of November 21. Ideas were discussed on tracking the gift tags and also on getting the gifts returned on time.

Advent Evening will be held Dec. 1<sup>st</sup>. It was decided not to invite Santa Claus this year, but the K of C will be asked to donate treat bags as usual. Geri Zaruba has four crafts planned, four games planned and possibly an area for a family photo to be taken.

The Christmas Bake Sale will be held the weekend of Dec. 4-5 after the Masses. Sharon Hernandez has offered to chair the event this year. A notice will be placed in the bulletin for the two weekends prior to the sale asking for baked goods to be donated. We will not advertise for extra mini bread loaves this year, as we seem to receive plenty.

The Christmas Fruit baskets will be assembled and delivered December 19, 2010. Gina Woods has offered to chair the event this year.

Going Bananas is scheduled to be held April 1-3, 2011 at GI Central Catholic. The banana splits will be served April 2. Resurrection juniors and seniors will be asked to volunteer, with GICC seniors filling vacancies as needed.
