1. Jim Kurtenbach was welcomed as a new member of the committee.
2. A DVD by Scott Hahn has not been found.
3. A decision was made to end the discussion on the book, One Voice, One Church.
4. The committee would like to arrange for three sessions on Scripture, Tradition, and Sacraments during Lent. These sessions would take place in Sunday evenings from 6:30-7:30 PM. Sister Jean will contact Sister Leona for the Scripture. The Diocesan Chancellor, Kathy Hahn, was chosen for Tradition, and Bishop Dendinger for Sacraments. (Sister Leona was contacted and is willing to do this piece and remuneration needs to be discussed.)
5. Bulletin inserts prepared for the new liturgical changes that had been given to the secretary last spring have not been in the bulletin to date. Pat said that there was not room to print them.
6. The latter led to a discussion about the need to ask the Parish Council for printing needs to publish a 17x11 inch bulletin, if Resurrection is not equipped to do this now.
7. Thirty ministers participated in the ministry in-service presented by Father Jim Schmitt in September. For those who did not participate, Sister Jean will call each person to determine if he/she wants to continue ministering and set a date for another in-service. (This will be Thursday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, at 7:00 PM.
8. Because many parishioners serve in more than one ministry, scheduling is a challenge. A discussion about the possibility to get a computer application for scheduling led to a discussion to ask Joan Wiese/Julie Bresenski for information about this. (Sister Jean will contact). Is it possible?  
to use the computers we now have for this purpose?
9. The annual appreciation dinner for musicians will take place in January when scheduling allows. (Geri will take to Pat about calendar openings).
10. The committee will study the book, Catholic Customs and Traditions.
11. Again, we discussed the topic about why people leave our Church. Some members have heard People say that they like the Bible discussions in other churches. One parishioner who had participated in two different church Bible groups said that they are not different from what Resurrection has offered on Sundays and Tuesdays. We talked about the emphases that other churches give to youth, and that this is a huge factor that drives people to those churches. After classes in these churches, youth can go and play in a gym or a game room. This may be the draw that eventually causes parents to leave our Church.
12. Is it possible to publish the weekly Scripture readings in the Sunday bulletin?
13. The Advent Evening will not include Mass this year.
14. Sister Jean noted that Blessed Sacrament, St. Leo's, and St. Mary's all have copies of the new music in the pews and are learning the new music. Bonnie said that only certain parts of the ordinary may be used at this time.
15. Patti volunteered to do minutes starting with the November 14<sup>th</sup> meeting.
